
Dear Sir:

We have recently received the enclosed "Notice of the Proposed Establishment of a Public-Use Airport," 83-ASW-0029-NRA, Hahnville, Louisiana, which was issued on March 8, 1983 by the Federal Aviation Administration. The notice involves a potential general aviation airport for small aircraft within St. Charles Parish. The action proposed to be taken by the FAA is to add the site to the National Airport System Plan, a routine and pro forma first step which does not necessarily mean that the site will be used and does not constitute a commitment for Federal funding.

It is our understanding that the St. Charles Parish Council has under consideration four alternative sites for such an airport, but that the Council has taken no formal action approving construction of an airport or selecting any of the sites. We will be monitoring the activities of the Council concerning the proposed general aviation airport and will keep you advised of any new developments.

NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT OF A PUBLIC-USE AIRPORT

83-ASW-0029-NRA

HAHNVILLE, LOUISIANA

The Federal Aviation Administration has received notice of the proposed establishment of a public-use airport. Details are listed below:

Name : St. Charles Parish Airport Proponent: St. Charles Parish Council

Location : Hahnville, Louisiana Latitude : 29°56'46"

Elevation: 3' AMSL Longitude: 90°26'23"

Layout : It is proposed to establish a public-use airport. The initial construction will be a 3,800' X 75' asphalt Runway 5/23. It will then be ultimately extended and widened to 5,000' X 100' with parallel taxiway.

Number and Type of Based Aircraft and Operations:

It is estimated to initially have 43 aircraft based at the airport with approximately 1,700 landings per month. Within 5 years it is estimated to have 56 aircraft based at the airport with approximately 2,300 landings per month. IFR is not planned.

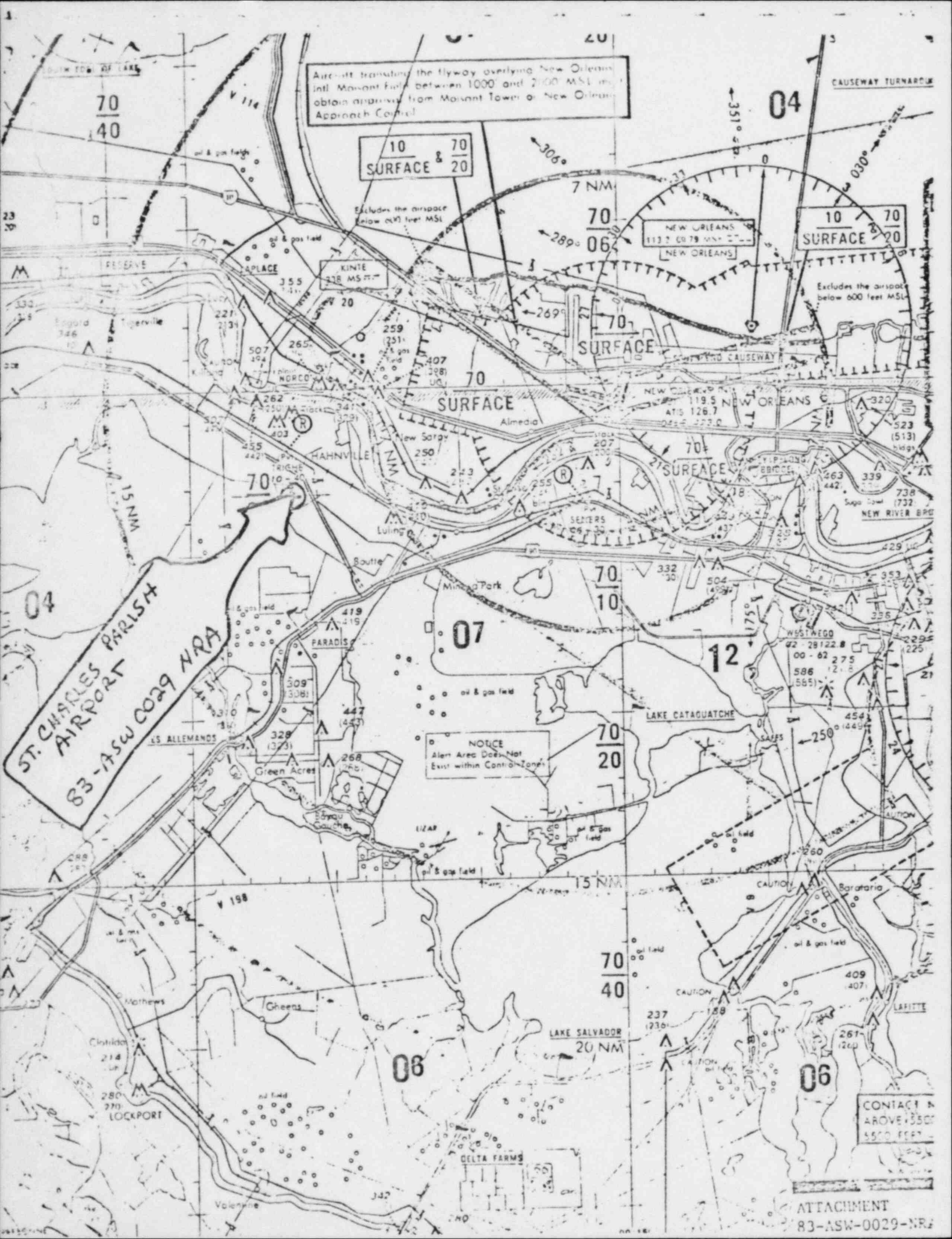
Interested persons are invited to submit written data concerning any comments or recommendations relative to the effect this proposal will have on the use of airspace by aircraft. Such communications should be submitted to the Airspace Specialist, Airspace and Procedures Branch, Federal Aviation Administration, P. O. Box 1689, Fort Worth, Texas 76101.

All communications received not later than April 8, 1983 will be considered before final action is taken.
