HOPE CREEK GENERATING STATION
TREATMENT WORKS APPROVAL
SEWER EXTENSION FOR CENTRALIZED WAREHOUSE

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:14A-12 et. seq., Public Service Electric and Gas (PSE&G) hereby submits an application for a Treatment Works Approval (TWA) for the construction of a sewer extension and lift station to serve the new centralized warehouse at the Hope Creek Generating Station.

The following documents, signed and sealed where applicable, are enclosed:

1. Standard Application (Form CP#1) - two copies;
2. Engineers Report for Sewer Systems (Form WQM-006) - two copies;
3. A copy of the letter to the local municipality requesting endorsement of the project;
4. An estimate of the construction costs for the sewerage facilities;
5. A copy of the receipt of Public Notification to the local planning board;
6. The appropriate USGS quadrangle map indicating the project site;
7. Construction Specifications - two copies; and
8. Final Plans and Profiles - two copies.


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The sewer extension will tie the centralized warehouse into a force main leading to the onsite sewage treatment plant. Treated effluent from the plant is discharged to the Delaware River through outfall DSN 462B which is regulated under NJPDES Permit No. NJ0025411. Over the past 12 months, this outfall has been in compliance with all NJPDES Permit limits and conditions. Because the design of the sewage treatment plant included provisions for warehouse personnel, there will be no increase in the hydraulic or pollutant loadings at the treatment plant.

In addition, PSE&G has issued Check No. 01568972 for \$385.19 made payable to Treasurer, State of New Jersey, Environmental Services Fund, to cover the application filing fee. This check was inadvertently submitted to the Department on or about March 14, 1991.
