Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

During a Unit No. 1 refueling outage concurrent with power operation on Unit No. 2, a fire barrier penetration LCO (No. 1-83-115) was issued on February 21, 1983, to permit the performance of work on the 20' elevation of the Service Water Building required for the installation of a plant modification. Due to the complexity of the work involved with this modification, the seven-day specified time frame of the subject LCO has been exceeded. Until completion of the involved modification work and cancellation of the subject LCO, appropriate stationed fire watches will remain in effect.
