Wells Eddleman's Response to NRC Staff's  
First Request for Admission

As negotiated between me and Charles A. Barth for the Staff, this response is filed under an agreed extension of time; responses to Staff interrogatories will be filed the first week of May, if possible.

RESPONSE: See response to Applicants' first request for admission. In addition, it is not clear the Harris plant can be safely shut down absent the main condenser, given that clams or other organisms can also clog the RHR system heat exchangers, as occurred at CP&L's Brunswick nuclear plant (both units) in the spring of 1981. The ability of CP&L to maintain the RHR system operable is not firmly established in light of this. Also, Applicants have not established compliance with I&E Bulletin 79-01B, Supplement 3, which requires the reactors at Harris to be able to reach cold shutdown with equipment which is qualified to operate in a nuclear accident environment, to the best of my current knowledge. See Seabrook, LRP 82-171, 9/13/82.
