Dear Mr. Knighton:

Enclosed are seven copies of the Cultural Resources Protection Plan for Waterford Steam Electric Station - Unit Number 3 (Waterford 3). This document describes the procedure to be employed for protecting the two areas on the Waterford 3 property that have been determined to be eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.

This plan was originally contained in the Waterford 3 Environmental Protection Plan (EPP), but was removed from that document at the request of the NRC staff as a result of their review of the November 12, 1982 EPP submittal (Reference 2). The Cultural Resources Protection Plan is now a separate document, incorporated by reference into the EPP. A revised EPP which reflects this, and other changes that have been made subsequent to this review is being submitted to the docket. The Cultural Resources Protection Plan document was removed from the EPP in its entirety, and has not been altered in content or verbage. Only minor formatting changes have been made (addition of a title page and renumbering of sections from that in the EPP) to be consistent with the revision of the plan into a separate


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document. Everything is essentially the same as sections 2.3 and 4.2 of the EPP submitted on November 12, 1982, the sections of the EPP pertaining to cultural resources protection which were reviewed by the NRC and Louisiana State Historic Preservation Office staffs.

A copy of this submittal is being forwarded to Mr. Robert B. DeBlieux, Louisiana State Historic Preservation Officer.

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
