Subject: Generic Letter 90-03
Vendor Interface for Safety-Related Components

Dear Sir:

The purpose of this letter is to advise the NRC that the action items suggested by the subject generic letter are complete for Crystal River Unit 3. On March 20, 1990, the NRC issued the subject generic letter to all licensees requesting them to review their present vendor interface programs and modify them as necessary using the guidance supplied in the generic letter.

By letter dated September 24, 1990, Florida Power Corporation (FPC) responded to Generic Letter 90-03 and indicated that the program elements discussed in the generic letter were already included in our vendor interface program or would be implemented. Below are the commitments made in our response letter and the status of each.

1. The program with the NSSS vendor, Babcock & Wilcox, will be revised to include revised test procedures and updated replacement parts information by December 31, 1990.

STATUS: Completed on December 21, 1990.

2. A list of key vendors with which periodic contact will be maintained will be identified by April 26, 1991.


STATUS: Completed on March 25, 1991.

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The NRC's letter dated October 30, 1990, found our response acceptable based on the completion of the above commitments. Therefore, FPC considers all actions required by Generic Letter 90-03 completed.
