Appendix R - Scheduler Exemption Request

Gentlemen:


In our July 1, 1982, (ØCANØ782Ø2) transmittal of our Appendix R analysis results, we requested a scheduler exemption for proposed modifications to fire zones 2100Z and 2101AA (both of Unit 2) based on long lead times on procurement of the necessary switchgear equipment. Corroborating documentation was provided you via our letter dated July 29, 1982 (ØCANØ78217).

As stated in the latter correspondence, approximately 12-14 months is required for delivery of this equipment once an order has been placed. We have not yet begun procurement efforts pending receipt of an approval to our exemption request, and it is now our concern that a significant delay in granting the exemption may result in our not being able to complete installation of the switchgear during the 2R4 outage as requested.

In order for us to meet the 2R4 schedule, we request your prompt approval of the requested scheduler exemption.
