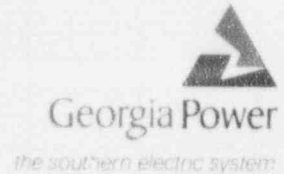


Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant
Relocation of the Backup Emergency Operations Facility

Gentlemen:

By letter dated April 22, 1993, the NRC staff approved the relocation of the backup Emergency Operations Facility (EOF) from Baxley, Georgia to the Plant Hatch Emergency News Center complex in Vidalia, Georgia. On May 20, 1994, an emergency exercise was successfully conducted which involved actual evacuation to the newly relocated backup EOF. Procedures governing relocation to, and activation of the backup EOF are in place. A revision to the Emergency Plan in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q) was submitted on September 15, 1994 to reflect the new location of the backup EOF.


