REQUEST FOR RELIEF CONCERNING LEAK RATE ISSUE.

Significant information has come out of the GPU vs B&W trial record and subsequent "Briefing on Staff Review of GPU vs B&W "Public Meeting of April 6, 1983. The particular issue that I seek relief from is the "falsification of leak rate calculations."

The issue of falsification of leak rate calculations has been left hanging for 3 1/2 years. Presently the Department of Justice is looking into the possibility of criminal action against principles that are employees of GPUNC, the present operators of TMI#1.

There is a very real possibility and concern that TMI #1 will restart with the very same management and operators that were involved in the criminal falsification of leak data prior to the accident on 3-29-79.

RELIEF SOUGHT:

Allowing the reactor to restart with the very same actors in responsible positions that face criminal charges for falsification of data will not provide adequate safety to the general public. I respectfully petition that a restart decision be delayed until all criminal investigations by the Department of Justice are concluded and released to the intervenors and staff.
