

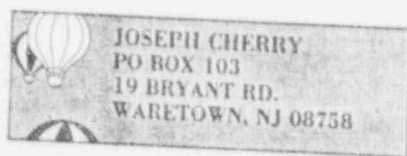
Dear Senator Bradley,
