lived here. But your-
self in our position stop
those hearings now.

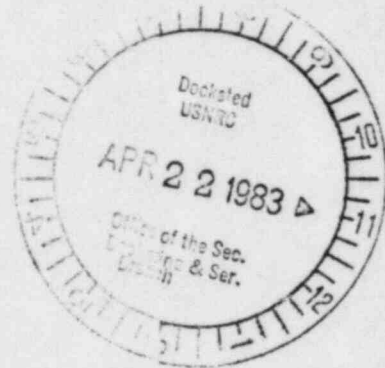
