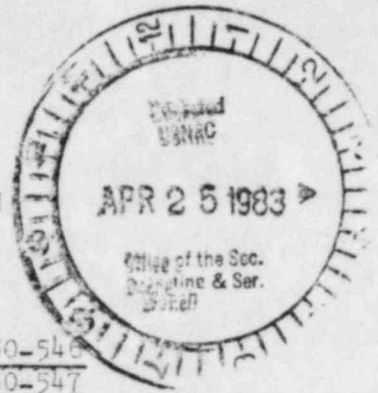

SAVE THE VALLEY'S PETITION TO INTERVENE

Comes now Save TheValley by its agents herein, and for cause of Petition
To Intervene, states:

1. That pursuant to 10 CFR Sec. 2.714, Harold G. Cassidy, Ph.D., 605 West Second Street, Madison, Indiana 47250, (Emeritus Professor, Chemistry, Yale University) and Fred Hauck, R. R. #3, Tower Heights, Shelbyville, Kentucky 40065, (Consulting Engineer, Hauck Associates, Box 397, Shelbyville, Kentucky 40065), on behalf of Save The Valley, (hereinafter called STV), do hereby Petition for Leave to Intervene in connection with the application of Public Service Company of Indiana and Wabash Valley Power Association for license to operate Units 1 & 2 of the Marble Hill Nuclear Generating Station, as published in the Madison Courier, a newspaper of general circulation within Jefferson County, Indiana, on April 7, 1983.

2. That STV is a Kentucky corporation registered in the State of Indiana with the Secretary of State.

3. (a) That STV is comprised of membership of citizens of Jefferson County, Indiana, Trimble County, Kentucky, Oldham County, Kentucky, Shelby County, Kentucky, Jefferson County, Kentucky, including the City of Louisville therein, and adjacent counties in Indiana and Kentucky; that said members are the owners of property adjacent to the proposed Marble Hill Nuclear Generating Station located in Jefferson County, Indiana, known and referred to as Marble Hill.
