

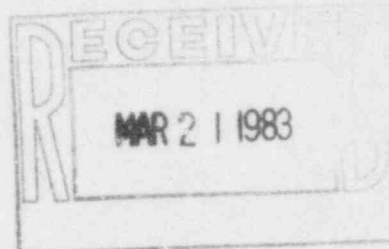

IE Inspection Report No. 50-298/82-34

Dear Mr. Madsen:

The subject report, dated February 17, 1983, forwarded the results of the Emergency Preparedness Appraisal Followup conducted by NRC staff members during the period December 6-10, 1982. NPPD was requested to respond to the open items listed in the report within 60 days of the date of the letter (i.e. by April 18, 1983).

The District is currently in the process of revising the Cooper Nuclear Station Emergency Plan and the Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures in preparation for the Spring 1983 emergency exercise. In addition, the District staff is formulating its response to Supplement I to NUREG-0737 (Generic Letter No. 82-33) for submittal no later than April 15, 1983. These ongoing efforts will address many of the open items listed in the Emergency Preparedness Appraisal Inspection Report.

The District desires additional time to comment on this report in order to more efficiently allocate staff resources and to have the advantage of the emergency exercise experience and resultant regulatory agency critiques. Accordingly, the District respectfully requests an additional 30 days within which to respond to IE Inspection Report No. 50-298/82-34.
