

Enclosed is a copy of the 1982 report on the Preoperational Environmental Radiological Monitoring Program for the Clinton Power Station. This annual report was prepared by Hazelton Environmental Sciences. The ingestion pathways, airborne, waterborne and direct radiation were monitored and reported. All of the data was within expected ranges, and none of the radioactivity in the samples was attributable to CPS.
