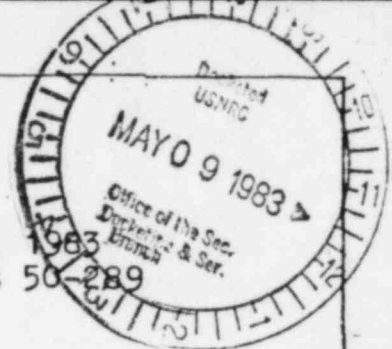

SUBJECT: BOARD NOTIFICATION 83-08, TMI-1 Restart Hearing

Your memorandum to the Commission (February 1, 1983) concerning the above Board Notification was recently brought to our attention.

The small amount of information transmitted in your memo is not sufficient to indicate the significance of the matter to the issues of the Restart Proceeding. The matter appears to relate to cheating and test administration at TMI, presumably the licensing exam. You note that the matter has nexus to the Restart Proceeding. It is, therefore, the legitimate interest of other parties to the Restart Proceeding, in addition to the Staff (who is also a party), and complete information should be provided to all parties. The matter may have significance and may affect conclusions of various parties concerning restart of Unit 1.

We request the following:

1. That you check whether all parties to the TMI-1 Restart Proceeding have received your memorandum.
2. That you provide the Board Notification referenced in your memorandum.
3. That you indicate what members of the NRC Staff are conducting the investigation that is the subject of your memorandum and the Board Notification.
4. That you advise us of the status of the Staff investigation.
5. That you provide the Staff investigation when completed.
6. That you provide a complete description of the allegation.

We would appreciate your attention to what appears to us to be selective withholding of information.
