

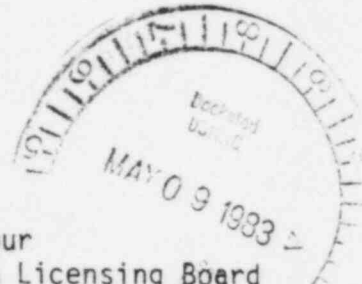

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Dear Sirs:

It has come to our attention that a memo has been circulated to all licensing boards regarding pilot operated relief valves (porv). The memo, dated April 4, advises licensing boards to pay special attention to the issue of porv environmental qualification and safety qualifications (safety-grade requirements) in operating license proceedings. We have not received a copy of this memo.

While the Coalition has not yet been admitted as a party to this proceeding, we believe that not to receive such notifications prejudices our future involvement in this case. For example, as you may recall, our proposed Contention 7 addresses the very issue which is the subject of the April 4 memorandum.

We would appreciate some action by the Board to ensure that the organization is kept fully notified of issues regarding the operating license for WNP-1 by the NRC Staff.
