

Dear Chairman Bloch:

This is to confirm your response to a question posed by Applicants regarding Judge Jordan's inquiry into the delegation of authority to County Judges to make certain decisions regarding notification of and recommendations for protective action to the public in the event of a radiological emergency. Specifically, Applicants requested that Judge Jordan identify the particular comments in the emergency plan for Comanche Peak which he had indicated recommended that someone be assigned to assist the County Judge in the exercise of that authority.

In response to our request, you informed us that Judge Jordan was referring to recommendations made by a reviewer of the Hood and Somervell County Plans. These recommendations are set forth in Attachment G (p. 21) of both plans, which may be found at page 188 of the Somervell County Plan and pages 199-200 of the Hood County Plans. By copy of this letter we are advising the other parties of this information.
