PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

Martha Drake, 230 Fairview Petoskey, Michigan, and Dan Drake, 1912 Teddes Ave., Ann Arbor, Michigan wish to intervene in the above matter.

They claim standing on grounds that Dan lives within 50 miles of the plant, that they are members of the cooperatives owning the plant, and that they are citizens and residents of Michigan and that the whole state will be affected by the safety and economic health of the plant.


They claim that they can contribute to a full hearing on this case.

They further claim that without a cooperative member from northern Michigan there cannot be a full hearing on this case.

Their contentions are that there are unresolved safety matters, that there are unresolved problems with the amount and effects of low level radiation from the plant, that the health effects from the radon due to mining uranium for the plant are hazardous, and that the cooperatives are not financially able to own and operate the plant.
