Dear Dr. Murley:

In connection with the Joint Application of the Long Island Lighting Company ("LILCO") and the Long Island Power Authority ("LIPA") to transfer to LIPA the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station ("Shoreham") and Facility Operating License NPF-82 (as modified to reflect Shoreham's defueled possession-only status) ("Joint Application"), I am providing the following supplementary information:

Effective June 24, 1991, LIPA has undertaken certain organizational changes which will affect in a minor but affirmative way the administrative structure for control of the Shoreham plant following its transfer to LIPA. Specifically, the current LIPA position of Executive Director and General Counsel will be changed to President of Shoreham Project and General Counsel. This position, as redesignated, will continue to be occupied by Stanley B. Klimberg; the position description will be modified as reflected in Enclosure 1. Reporting responsibilities relating to Shoreham (see Joint Application, Appendix C, Exhibit 1), will reflect this adjustment, i.e., the Executive Vice President, Shoreham Project will report to the President of Shoreham Project, who in turn will report to the LIPA Chairman and the LIPA Board of Trustees.

LIPA has determined that this organizational revision should be made in order to strengthen LIPA's ability to manage the Shoreham Project. Under the revised structure, Mr. Klimberg, as President of Shoreham Project, will be freed of some non-Shoreham duties and hence will be able to devote a greater portion of his time and attention to Shoreham-related matters. This change will accommodate the increased workloads anticipated for Mr. Klimberg in connection with transfer of the license and the Shoreham plant to LIPA and with approval and implementation of the Decommissioning Plan.

In addition, the list of LIPA's trustees and officers provided in the Joint Application, pp. 13-14, is updated and modified as shown in Enclosure 2. There are now two vacancies on the LIPA Board.
