Dear Mr. Lowenstein:

I enclose herewith three executed and five conformed copies of Amendment No. 5 submitting proof of financial protection in connection with Saxton's application for an operating license.

The proof of financial protection includes a letter dated May 19, 1961, from NEMLA stating that NEMLA is prepared to increase the present limit of liability from \$1,000,000 to \$3,500,000 as soon as NEMLA is advised of the date on which Saxton will require the higher limit. The upper limit of \$3,500,000 has been computed in accordance with the formula contained in Section 100.32 of the Commission's regulations and is based on a maximum power level of 10,000 thermal kilowatts (the maximum of power level for which an operating license is sought at this time) and a population factor of 1.2. To facilitate your review of the population factor, reference is made to Figures 101-1 and 102-1 and to Table 103-1 contained in the Final Safeguards Report submitted with Amendment No. 5, dated April 20, 1961, to Saxton's license application.
