Implementation of a Proposed Amendment to the
Unit 1 and Unit 2 Technical Specification 4.5.6.2.b

The purpose of this submittal is to supplement a proposed change to Technical Specifications dated June 12, 1990 (ST-HL-AE-3485) regarding the deletion of the Autoclosure Interlock on the Residual Heat Removal suction valves. This supplement proposes to implement the proposed change on Unit 2 at the second refueling outage (2RE02) using Attachment 1 and to implement the proposed change at the fourth refueling outage (1RE04) for Unit 1 using Attachment 2. 2RE02 is scheduled to begin in September of 1991 and 1RE04 is scheduled to begin in October of 1992.

The Determination of No Significant Hazards provided in the June 12, 1990 submittal remains unchanged by this supplemental information and the previous determination that the proposed change does not have a significant effect on the quality of the environment remains unchanged.

The STPEGS Nuclear Safety Review Board has reviewed and approved the proposed changes.

In accordance with 10CFR50.91(b), HL&P is providing the State of Texas with a copy of this supplement.

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



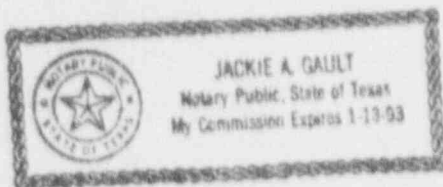
