EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (EAP) SUMMARY  
FOR JANUARY 1, TO JUNE 30, 1991

From January 1 through June 30, 1991, our records indicate two (2) positive tests for Duquesne Light Company employees. One (1) employee was terminated and one (1) was admitted to the EAP. One (1) employee, who was tested positive in the report period ending 12-31-90, had access restored.

#### MRO COMMENTS ON MANAGEMENT ACTIONS

1. Corrective action results from problem identified in the 12-31-90 report:

In the December, 1990 report, Duquesne Light Company identified discrepancies with results reported on blind proficiency samples sent, and analyzed, by Roche Biomedical Laboratory, in Dublin, Ohio. Since this occurrence, Duquesne Light Company has initiated the services of Clinical Pathology Facility, as its primary lab as of March 1, 1991, and purchase FDA approved, blind proficiency samples from Bio-Rad Laboratories.

The corrective measures taken, to date, have proven to be effective.
