

REVISION TO TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION 3.4.6.2
REACTOR COOLANT SYSTEM PRESSURE ISOLATION VALVES

Union Electric Company herewith transmits an application for amendment to Facility Operating License Number NPF-30 for the Callaway Plant. This amendment application requests a revision to Technical Specification 3/4.4.6 and associated Bases to change the allowed leakage limit for reactor coolant system pressure isolation valves. This amendment provides criterion whereby each valve is permitted a leakage limit based on valve size.

The Callaway Plant On-Site Review Committee and the Nuclear Safety Review Board have reviewed and approved this amendment application. Attachments 1 through 3 provide the Technical Specification changes, Safety Evaluation, and Significant Hazards Evaluation, respectively. It has been determined that this amendment application does not involve any unreviewed safety questions, as defined in 10CFR50.59, nor a significant hazard consideration as determined per 10CFR50.92.
