This letter is being submitted in accordance with 10 CFR 20.302(a) as identified in IE Information Notice 83-05: Obtaining Approval for Disposal of Very-Low-Level Radioactive Waste - 10 CFR Section 20.302 (Log No. 1-745) dated February 24, 1983. The attachment, "Disposal of Low-Level Radioactively Contaminated Secondary-Side Clean-Up Resins in the On-Site Settling Basins at the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station" contains a report to support Toledo Edison's request for approval of procedures for disposal of Very-Low-Level Radioactive Waste for the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station Unit No. 1.

The attached report is for the use of the settling basins at Davis-Besse for disposal of low-level radioactive contaminated secondary-side condensate polisher demineralizer resins. The analysis includes a description of the licensed material involved with proposed manner and conditions of disposal. A description of the site, settling basin, dose criteria and environmental dose assessment are also included in the report.
