At approximately 5:30 p.m., on Friday, October 28, 1994, counsel for Gulf States Utilities Company received additional discovery requests from Cajun Electric Power Cooperative related to the River Bend Nuclear Station Long-Term Performance Improvement Plan. Similar discovery requests were objected to and a motion made for a protective order in "Gulf States Utilities Company's Objections to Cajun Electric Power Cooperative, Inc.
