02 | During normal operations a 115 KV offsite power line was removed from service on

03 | June 15, 16, 17, 20 and 21 for ten hours each day. Technical Specification 3.6.3

04 | requires that both 115 KV power lines "shall normally be available", but 3.6.3.b allows

05 | one 115 KV line to be deenergized for seven days. This was of minimal safety concern

06 | due to the fact that the other 115 KV line as well as both of the diesel generators

07 | were operable.

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CAUSE DESCRIPTION AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS 27

10 | The removal of the 115 KV line was to allow construction of a 115 KV power line for

11 | Unit II, which is currently under construction. The 115 KV line was returned to

12 | service each day.


Dear Dr. Murley,
