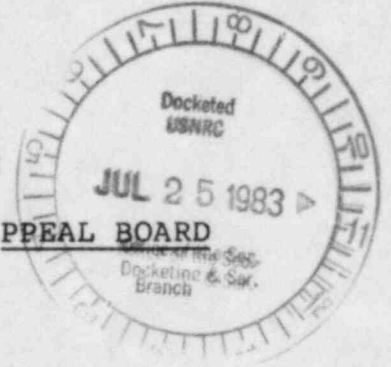

Joint Intervenors are currently in the process of preparing for the hearings on design quality assurance and have not yet decided which documents will be marked as exhibits in those hearings.



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
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
