Extension of Emergency Response Regualification

In accordance with Station procedures and 10CFR50.54(q), STPEGS plans to extend the allowed time interval for re-qualification training for specific Emergency Response Organization (ERO) Personnel.

STPEGS procedures, in accordance with NUREG 0654, require retraining ERO personnel every  $12 \pm 3$  months on the requirements of the Emergency Plan. The allowed re-qualification time of selected members of the Emergency Response Organization (ERO) will be extended one time only for two months from June 1, 1991 to August 1, 1991. This will result in a maximum interval of 17 months for this one time extension.

STPEGS is concluding a major enhancement of the Emergency Preparedness Program at the Station. The enhancements will become effective on August 1, 1991. Attachment 1 lists the current ERO positions for the Station. The extension will apply to the  $12 \pm 3$  month re-qualification cycle for all ERO personnel EXCEPT those identified with (\*) in Attachment 1. Note that Emergency Directors, Licensed Reactor Operators, Dose Assessment personnel and other key decision makers in the ERO will NOT be granted this extension.

The one-time extension is justified for the following reasons:

- Retraining these individuals on a program that will be substantially modified on August 1, 1991 is an ineffective use of training time and is counter-productive.
- ERO personnel will receive special Emergency Preparedness Training regarding the differences between the current program and the enhanced program prior to the effective date of the enhanced procedures.

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
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- Retraining during the June and July time frame would be "negative training" due to re-learning the old program (re-qualification), while simultaneously participating in the facility seminars and drills required to learn the enhanced program.

The extension in qualifications will NOT result in a decrease in the overall effectiveness of Emergency Preparedness at the Station. The STPEGS Emergency Plan will continue to meet the standards of 10CFR50.47(b) and Appendix E.
