As part of our effort in closing-out SER issues, we have identified the following issue which we believe has been resolved, yet has not been closed-out in the SER:

Reevaluate essential versus non-essential system (License Condition) -
This condition requires LP&L action upon issuance of revision 2 to Regulatory Guide 1.141. As the information available to us indicates that this revision will not be issued anytime in the near future, we believe that the requirement of evaluating that regulatory guide against Waterford 3 would be best identified at the time of issuance of the guide.

It is our understanding that no further action is required on our part until the NRC issues the subject Regulatory Guide, and as such we request that an SER supplement be written to remove this License Condition.
