CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ON AN ANNUAL FREQUENCY


This is in response to D. M. Verrelli's letter dated April 14, 1983 report numbers 50-438/83-07-02, 50-439/83-07-02 concerning activities at the Bellefonte Nuclear Plant which appeared to have been in violation of NRC regulations. The previous response to this violation was submitted on May 16, 1983. As discussed with NRC-OIE Inspector Linda Watson on June 21, 1983, the date of June 30, 1983 for completion of corrective actions indicated in our response on this matter will not be met. Because of unexpected delays in processing, only two of five vacancies have been filled with two additional offers having been made to qualified persons. The corrective action on this matter will be completed by September 30, 1983.
