Dear Mr. Knighton:

On July 22, 1983 Louisiana Power & Light Co. President, Mr. J. M. Cain, approved implementation of the attached Nuclear Operations Organization chart for the Waterford 3 Steam Electric Station. This organizational arrangement provides for the onsite and offsite management and technical resources deemed necessary to complete plant construction and conduct preoperational/startup testing in a timely manner. Additionally, this structure establishes an integrated project organization to support the safe and effective routine operation of Waterford 3 and includes the capabilities to respond to plant emergencies.

A key element in the restructuring of LP&L's Nuclear Operations Organization is the appointment of Mr. R. S. Leddick as Senior Vice President Nuclear Operations. In this regard it is requested that all future USNRC correspondence with LP&L be addressed to:


