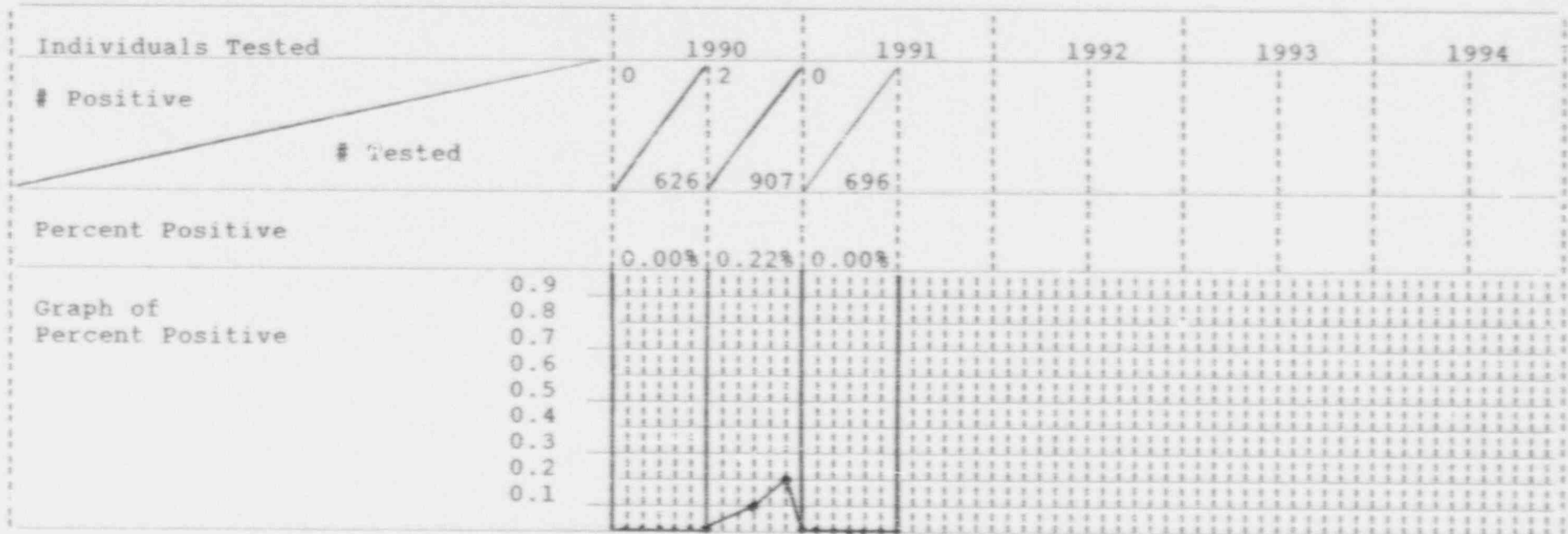

B. Lessons Learned:

1. Due to an increase in the MRO-recommended retests because of low creatinine, FFD has procured refractometers to measure specific gravity of each specimen prior to its being shipped from RBS.
2. Because of a weakness cited in recent RBS QA and NRC audits, FFD now generates a random testing list for select weekends and holidays throughout the year.
