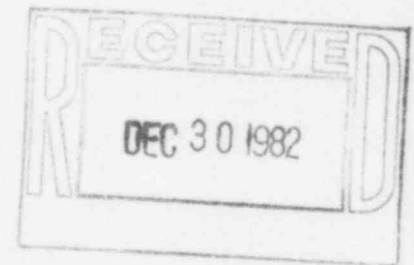

Dear Sir:

This letter is to advise you that the corrective action on the penetrations identified in the subject interim report has been completed.

The field heat treatment, attempted by Louisiana Power & Light/Ebasco site contractors, was not successful due to malfunctioning heat treat equipment. As a result of this, the two (2) penetrations were removed from the system and we supplied new, properly heat treated, penetrations to the site for installation. This installation was completed about the third week of November.

Based on the above actions, we therefore consider this to be a closed subject with no further action required by our organization.

In addition, as referenced in Item 3 of the subject letter, we have completed our review and investigation of similar assemblies supplied to other customers and nuclear sites.

It was determined from this investigation that remotely similar penetrations have been supplied to only one (1) other customer. The customer was Duke Power Co., McGuire Nuclear Station, Units 1 & 2.


We notified Duke Power and requested that they investigate and advise us of their conclusions.
