Implementation of a Proposed Amendment to the  
Unit 1 and Unit 2 Technical Specifications to Replace  
Spray Additive with Recirculation Fluid pH Control

The purpose of this submittal is to supplement a proposed change to Technical Specifications dated October 30, 1990 (ST-HL-AE-3378) regarding replacement of spray additive with recirculation fluid pH control. This supplement proposes to implement the proposed change to the combined Unit 1 and Unit 2 Technical Specifications at the second refueling outage on Unit 2 (2REO2) using Attachment 1 and to implement the proposed change at the fourth refueling outage (1REO4) for Unit 1 using Attachment 2. 2REO2 began September 13, 1991 and 1REO4 is scheduled to begin in October of 1992.

The Determination of No Significant Hazards provided in the October 30, 1990 submittal remains unchanged by this supplemental information and the previous determination that the proposed change does not have a significant effect on the quality of the environment remains unchanged.

In accordance with 10CFR50.91(b), HL&P is providing the State of Texas with a copy of this proposed amendment.

As stated in the October 30, 1990 letter, your approval is requested so that this change can be implemented for each unit during the respective refueling outages.
