APPLICANTS' DESIGNATION
OF WITNESSES

On September 14, 1983 the Board issued a Prehearing Conference Order. Therein the Board directed each party to provide

"the names of all witnesses who will testify in this proceeding and the subject area of this testimony shall be identified to the Board and the other parties according to the following schedule:

Contention 6--- September 19"

Applicants provide the following list of witnesses they may call in this proceeding with respect to Contention 6, and the subject areas of their testimony:¹


1. Applicants in their Supplemental Responses to Palmetto Alliance's Interrogatories and Requests to Produce Relating to Contention 6, September 8, 1983 identified witnesses Zwissler, Owen, Wells, Grier, Addis, McMeekin, Cobb, C. N. Alexander, Davison, Morgan, Shropshire, Allum, and Baldwin. Applicants also provided in that same document the subject areas of these witnesses testimony. Applicants reaffirm that they may call these witnesses' with regard to the subject matter described in the September 8, 1983 pleading. A copy of the relevant portions of that pleading is attached.

2. Applicants' September 8, 1983 pleading also makes reference to welding inspectors and supervisors. These individuals would be called to address expressions of technical and nontechnical concerns regarding QA/QC in welding at Catawba. The inspectors and supervisors that may be called are Messrs. J. R. Bryant, J. Rockholt, R. Childers, T. A. Bumgardner, W. H. Burr, C. Ferrell, B. Cauthen, H. Eubanks, J. E. Henson, V. C. Godfrey, R. Jones, L. Mauldin, J. McCoy, G. E. Ross, G. McDowell, M. Standridge, L. Harris, W. Leeper, D. Bentley, D. Deaton, R. Sims, L. D. Jackson, K. W. Karriker, D. Wright, R. Kirkland, J. Standridge, W. Trout, A. S. Gantt, S. Ledford, R. Irby, C. Crisp, J. Costello, and R. J. Rogers.
3. Applicants may call L. Davison, S. Alexander and S. Dressler to respond to the concerns of Messrs. McAfee and Hoopingarner admitted by the Board.

Applicants note that the decision to call a particular witness will be made at the hearing. Applicants further note that, as the Board recognized in the September 8 Prehearing Conference Order (at p. 3), rebuttal testimony by Applicants (either by the above identified witnesses or others) may be necessary "to address unanticipated matters arising during cross-examination." Again, a decision to call such rebuttal witnesses will be made at the hearing.
