
Response to Request for Additional Information Regarding Generic Letter 93-04

Reference: NRC Correspondence from T. W. Alexion to W. T. Cottle, dated  
December 13, 1994, (ST-AE-HL-93999)

The referenced letter requested that Houston Lighting & Power either commit to implement the current order timing modification and the new current order surveillance test (to be done each refueling outage) prior to startup from the next refueling outage that begins later than three months from receipt of the letter, or provide an alternative long-term plan and schedule. This letter is to notify the NRC that the current order timing modification will be implemented in South Texas Project Units 1 and 2 during their refueling outages currently scheduled in 1995. Houston Lighting & Power will notify the NRC in writing after the modifications are complete in both Units.

This letter is also to notify the NRC that the South Texas Project preventive maintenance program has been revised to require the new current order surveillance test to be performed during each refueling outage of each Unit.




