1994 YEAR IN PERSPECTIVE

The following are some of the more noteworthy achievements of GGNS employees during 1994:

- Plant performance records were set in:
 - Energy produced (>10M gross megawatt-hours)
 - Capacity factor (>96%)
 - Capability factor (>92%)
- Grand Gulf continued its downward trend on 3 year average production cost. We have reduced cost from 23.8 mils/kwhr in 1989 to 18.6 mils/kwhr in 1994. One year costs for 1994 (a non-outage year) came in at a record-breaking 14.2 mils/kwhr.
- Significant milestones were achieved in the area of safety performance including:
 - SALP 1 rating and continued recognition on NRC's "good performer" list
 - Strong response to common mode failure concerns associated with SSW pump and scram solenoid valve degradation
 - Innovative approaches to regulatory burden reduction which evolved into proposed rulemaking on Appendix J and 10CFR50.55a
 - Continued industry leadership on significant safety/regulatory issues such as maintenance rule implementation, Technical Specification improvement and graded QA



