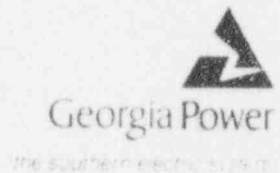

Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant
Physical Security Plan Revision

Gentlemen:

In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54 (p)(2), Georgia Power Company (GPC) hereby submits a report of changes to the Physical Security Plan (PSP) for the Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant. The areas addressed in the revision involve the following:

1. Clarification of responsibilities for certain nuclear security supervisory personnel.
2. Modification of the frequency for performing refresher security training for general plant employees
3. Deletion of the requirement to use certain protective equipment.
4. Revision of position titles to reflect current titles.

Georgia Power Company has determined the enclosed changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the Plant Hatch Physical Security Plan. The changes and a justification for the determination of no decrease in safeguards effectiveness are presented as Enclosure 1. Enclosure 2 contains revision insertion instructions and the revised Physical Security Plan pages.

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
