Gentlemen:

By letter dated April 5, 1982, Georgia Power Company (GPC) proposed an amendment to the Plant Hatch Unit 1 Technical Specifications (Appendix A to the Operating License). This amendment would have changed the requirements for the High Pressure Coolant Injection (HPCI) system and the Reactor Core Isolation Cooling (RCIC) system to require both to be operable at reactor pressures greater than 150 psig. GPC hereby withdraws this proposal from further consideration by the NRC.
