Agreement for Services

Pending establishment of a Nuclear Managing Board and its formal authorization for Georgia Power Company (GPC) to enter into the Nuclear Services Agreement with Southern Nuclear Operating Company, Inc. (Southern Nuclear), GPC and Southern Nuclear have agreed as follows:

1. Effective January 1, 1991, GPC's nuclear support employees currently assigned to the SONOPCO Project will transfer to Southern Nuclear. Messrs. R.P. McDonald, W.G. Hairston, J.T. Beckham and C.K. McCoy will also continue to be employees of GPC, via shared employment agreements, with direct responsibility to GPC for operation of Plant Hatch and Plant Vogtle.
2. Beginning January 1, 1991, Southern Nuclear will furnish to GPC certain non-operating support services, including corporate nuclear support; safety, audit and engineering review; nuclear technical services; and administrative and executive services related to these personnel.
3. Southern Nuclear shall not perform any activities which are required by the NRC operating licenses to be performed directly by GPC as licensee; operating responsibility for the plants shall remain under the direct management and control of GPC employees (including the shared officers listed in 1. above).
4. GPC shall remain fully responsible as Agent on its own behalf and on behalf of Oglethorpe, MEAG and Dalton, the co-owners of Plants Hatch and Vogtle. Southern Nuclear is not replacing GPC with respect to any Agency functions.
5. GPC will pay Southern Nuclear for services provided hereunder at their actual cost, in accordance with applicable rules, regulations and orders of the Securities and Exchange Commission. Costs shall include both direct charges related to Plants Hatch and Vogtle, as well as other charges which should be allocated to GPC in a fair and equitable manner.
6. The Limitation of Liability and Indemnification provisions of the proposed Nuclear Services Agreement shall apply to this agreement.

This agreement shall remain in effect through March 31, 1991, unless earlier replaced by the Nuclear Services Agreement or otherwise terminated by GPC.
