In the Reference 1 letter, Exelon Generation Company, LLC (EGC), requested relief from the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code, Section XI, "Rules for Inservice Inspection of Nuclear Power Plant Components." This relief request applied to the fourth 10-year interval Inservice Inspection (ISI) program, which concluded on December 31, 2018 for Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station (PBAPS), Units 2 and 3. In the Reference 2 email, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission requested additional information.

In that Relief Request, EGC requested relief from inspections of Emergency Service Water (ESW) component supports (Examination Category F-A, Item Number F1.40 (Component ID 0AP57-SC, 0BP57-SC)). Upon further review, EGC is withdrawing this portion of the relief request. All other aspects of the Reference 1 submittal are unaffected by this specific withdrawal.
