The Reference (a) letter transmitted ComEd's response to Reporting Requirement 1 of NRC Generic Letter (GL) 94-02, "Long-Term Solutions and Upgrade of Interim Operating Recommendations for Thermal-Hydraulic Instabilities in Boiling Water Reactors" for Quad Cities Station [Reference (b)].

In that letter, ComEd responded to Requested Action 1 of GL 94-02. This action requested ComEd to review the current procedures and training programs at Quad Cities Station, and modify them, as appropriate, to strengthen the administrative provisions intended to avoid power oscillations, or to detect and suppress them if they occur prior to implementation of the long-term solutions. In response to that request, ComEd committed to complete the requested actions for Quad Cities Station by December 31, 1994.

Generic Letter 94-02 also included Reporting Requirement 2, which required notification of the NRC within 30 days following completion of Requested Action 1 of GL 94-02. The purpose of this letter is to inform the NRC that all procedure changes required by Requested Action 1 of Generic Letter 94-02 were completed at Quad Cities Station on December 31, 1994. The majority of operating crews were trained by December 31, 1994, however, due to training schedule conflicts, certain remaining operating crews were trained by January 6, 1995. ComEd regretfully apologizes for any inconveniences that this may pose to the NRC staff.

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

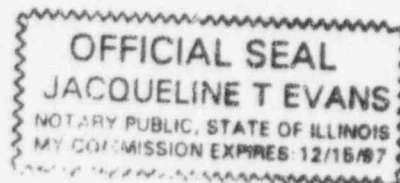
