Section 13.1.3.25 of the SNPS FSAR (Attachment 1) has been revised in response to a concern of the NRC Resident Inspector (references 1 and 2). The revised section conforms to ANSI N18.1-1971, "Selection and Training of Nuclear Power Plant Personnel" with regard to the minimum qualifications of the Health Physics and Radio-Chemistry technicians and should address the Resident Inspector's concerns. The new text will be incorporated into the next revision of the FSAR.

13.1.3.25 Technicians

Technicians will be high school graduates or equivalent. Technicians in responsible positions shall have a minimum of two years of working experience in their speciality (eg. Health Physics, Chemistry, or Instrumentation and Controls). These personnel should have a minimum of one year related technical training in addition to their experience.
