NRC GENERIC LETTER 94-02, "LONG-TERM SOLUTIONS AND UPGRADE OF INTERIM
OPERATING RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THERMAL-HYDRAULIC INSTABILITIES IN BWRS"

Gentlemen:

The purpose of this letter is to notify the NRC staff notification of completion of activities associated with Action 1 of NRC Generic Letter (GL) 94-02, "Long-Term Solutions and Upgrade of Interim Operating Recommendations for Thermal-Hydraulic Instabilities in Boiling Water Reactors" for Carolina Power & Light Company's Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Units 1 and 2.

NRC GL 94-02 was issued on July 11, 1994. Action 1 of this generic letter requested licensees to "review their current procedures and training programs and modify them as appropriate to strengthen the administrative provisions intended to avoid power oscillations or to detect and suppress them if they occur prior to implementation of a long-term solution." CP&L responded to NRC GL 94-02 on September 9, 1994. CP&L committed in that response to complete procedure revisions and training necessary to implement the revised BWR Owner's Group interim guidelines by November 30, 1994. Procedure revisions and training have been completed and the improved guidance has been implemented. CP&L believes that implementation of the improved BWR Owners' Group guidelines satisfies the intent of NRC GL 94-02, Action 1. This letter satisfies the 30 day reporting requirements from NRC GL 94-02 for Action 1.
