3. Any and all reports of failure to conform with such policies concerning Robert C. Thornberry, Steven W. Skidmore and/or the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant facility.
4. All documents, reports, notes, memoranda, etc., concerning any conversations between NRC officials and representatives and representatives of Pacific Gas and Electric Company concerning job performance of Robert C. Thornberry and Steven W. Skidmore at the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant facility.
5. Any and all notes, documents, and/or reports reflecting complaints concerning job performance of Robert C. Thornberry or Steven W. Skidmore at the Pacific Gas and Electric Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant facility.


6. Any and all NRC requirements concerning fitness for duty of nuclear power plant operational employees on non-scheduled work time.
7. Any and all NRC regulations relative to substance abuse of plant managers or quality assurance control personnel assigned to nuclear power plant facilities.
8. Any and all documents, records, notes, memoranda, correspondence, etc., relating to any reprimand of Robert C. Thornberry, Steven W. Skidmore, and/or Pacific Gas and Electric Company for failure to adequately manage and respond to plant operating problems including problems relating to refueling and repair outages at the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant facility from January 1, 1980 through December 31, 1987.

The foregoing requests are made pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, Title V, United States Code, Section 552. The Freedom of Information Act provides that information is generally to be made available to the public.
