Subject: Docket No. 50-482: Requalification Reexamination Results


Dear Mr. Martin:

The purpose of this letter is to document discussions held on April 25, 1991 with Mr. John Pellet, Chief, Operator Licensing Section, U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Region IV, concerning the January 23, 1991 reexamination for an individual licensed at Wolf Creek Generating Station. As discussed with Mr. Pellet, Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC) has determined that at the time of the reexamination this individual was undergoing a period of significant personal stress that effected his ability to demonstrate his knowledge and skill level during the examination process. This individual is receiving counseling and intervention to address that stress.

Based upon this determination, WCNOC does not consider the January 23, 1991 reexamination to have been a valid measure of this individual's performance capabilities. Therefore, the reexamination should not be utilized in the consideration of any future licensing action (i.e., reexaminations) for this individual. This individual will need to successfully complete an NRC administered examination prior to resuming licensed duties.
