Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2
NUREG-0737 Item II.K.3.5, Automatic Trip of Reactor Coolant Pumps

Reference (1) forwarded the Combustion Engineering Owner's Group (CEOG) program description and schedule for resolving NUREG-0737 Item II.K.3.5, Automatic Trip of Reactor Coolant Pumps. Reference (1) noted that the CEOG program was scheduled for completion by the end of 1983 and that the Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO), on behalf of Millstone Unit No. 2, would forward tentative completion dates for operator training and Emergency Operating Procedures (EOP) revision (based on the CEOG program) by December 31, 1983.

Reference (2) notified the Staff that the revised Emergency Procedure Guidelines, which incorporate a new strategy for operating reactor coolant pumps, will not be available until April of 1984. Consequently, on or about May 1, 1984, we shall forward to the Staff the results of the CEOG program and the dates when operator training/EOP revision will be completed.

The Staff will be informed should any CEOG scheduler slippage adversely impact our plans to submit the above-noted status report.
