The small-scale exercise report, not dated, and the full scale exercise, dated October 13, 1983, were prepared by Region III of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

FEMA Region III staff will furnish a copy of the 1983 report to the State of Maryland and will request a schedule of action for correction of deficiencies. As soon as we receive and analyze the State's response, we will send you the results.
