Dear Mr. Denton:

Mr. D. G. Eisenhower's (NRC/ONRR) letter of December 21, 1983 (Generic Letter 83-40) concerning operator licensing examination requested information necessary for scheduling NRC manpower and resources to licensed operators and senior operators. Generic Letter 83-01 originally requested this information through 1985 (response submitted by my letter to Mr. Eisenhower dated February 21, 1983).

Please find attached updated information to that previously submitted along with additional information through fiscal year 1987. This best estimate of McGuire's need for operator licensing examinations includes identification of anticipated requests for site visits and the number of examinations for each visit. Note that the license applications are for licenses on both units, with no licenses being extended from one unit to the other. The NRC will be kept apprised of any significant changes in these estimates which may occur in the future.
