
Dear Chairman Bloch:

Enclosed herewith is a proposed Subpoena to compel the appearance of Ms. Dora D. Hatley for a deposition on February 15, 1984. We have also included a Notice of Deposition requesting same and a cover letter to Ms. Hatley for your signature, as you requested.

We request that you sign the Subpoena to allow us to serve it contemporaneously with the Notice of Deposition. We understand that Ms. Hatley is aware of matters concerning documentation and construction at Comanche Peak and the Cygna evaluation. 
